Cambrex Corp., an East Rutherford-based provider of services to the pharmaceutical industry, said Monday it acquired Germany's **IEP GmbH**, a seller of enzymes to the pharmaceutical industry. The firm will be renamed **Cambrex IEP**; financial terms were not disclosed.



Central

Bridgewater's **Nistica**, a supplier of optical modules for high-bandwidth communications, said Monday it closed \$6.5 million in series C funding. Investors include **Battelle Ventures**, **Novitas Capital**, **Technology Venture Partners**, **NTT Electronics Corp.** and **Fujikua**.

South

SX Landfill Energy LLC, a subsidiary of **Energenic**, in Mays Landing, said Monday it inked a 20-year agreement to design, build, own and operate a facility in Lafayette that will use landfill gas as an energy source to generate electricity. The 3.2 megawatt SX Renewable Energy Generation Facility will be built at the Sussex County Solid Waste and Recycling Facility. Energenic is a joint venture of **Marina Energy**, a subsidiary of **South Jersey Industries**, and **DCO Energy**.
