

## **Mays Landing firm to operate Pa. casino's heating, cooling system**

The energy company that operates the heating and cooling system for the Borgata Hotel Casino & Spa has been tapped to do the same for the Parx Casino in Bensalem, Pa.

Mays Landing-based Energenic said Wednesday that its PPB Energy Partners LLC is entering into a 15-year agreement with the casino to own and operate the Central Utility Plant, which will provide heating and cooling and emergency power to the casino property.

Energenic is owned by DCO Energy and Marina Energy, a subsidiary of South Jersey Industries.

The Central Utility Plant will become operational sometime this month, casino officials said. Parx is expected to open Friday, and replaces the old Philadelphia Park Casino & Racetrack.
