



Seabrook Farms to Install More Than 21 Acres of Solar Panel Systems in Upper Deerfield

UPPER DEERFIELD TWP. — Another solar panel system is coming to Upper Deerfield Township.

This one is coming to an open farm area for the private use of a local family business. SBS Energy Partners, LLC announced Tuesday a 15-year agreement with Seabrook Farms to install and maintain more than 21 acres of solar panel systems at its facility here.

This location will hold approximately 27,000 panels, with each producing about 230 watts of electricity. Construction is expected to begin in 4-6 weeks, once permits and designs are finalized, according to Joanne Brigandi, the Director of Corporate Communication for SJI Services, LLC, a subsidiary of South Jersey Industries.
