# South: Gaming Power

FOLSOM Marina Energy, a subsidiary of energy holding company South Jersey Industries, and joint venture partner DCO Energy in West Atlantic City entered into contract with Boyd Gaming to develop, own and operate an energy center for Boyd's \$4 billion Echelon Place hotel and casino under construction in Las Vegas. The center will provide chilled water for cooling, hot water for heating and 16 megawatts of emergency electrical power for the Echelon's 5,000 guestrooms, 140,000 square feet of casino space, 750,000 square feet of meeting space and 300,000 square feet of retail space.

Marina's and DCO's joint venture, LVE Energy Partners, will start building the new energy facility this summer. Echelon is going up as a replacement for the demolished Stardust Resort & Casino and is expected to open by 2010.
